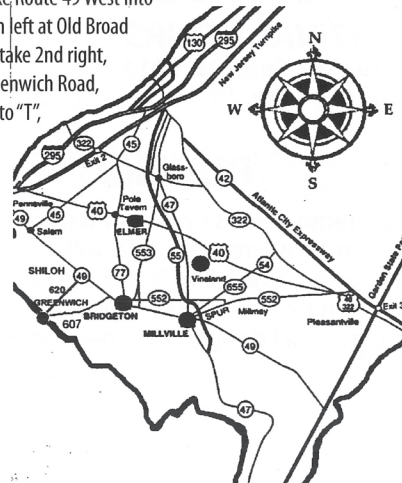

SLIDES/PHOTOS

Each slide/photo must be marked with the applicant's name and address and include an arrow indicating the top of the work, placed on the side of slide from which the work will be viewed and on the back of photo. Include four of your work and one of your display booth containing your work, and indicate the number that corresponds with the description for that slide/photo on the application form.

- Slides must be standard 2"x2" 35mm in good condition (no glass, no tape, no metal).
- Slides/photos must be current and must accurately reflect work to be exhibited.
- We will not jury your work without a booth slide/photo. Booth slides/photos are important, both in terms of your presentation as well as your overall work.
- Slides/photos will be kept until the end of the festival for publicity and recheck purposes.

RULES & STANDARDS

In an effort to provide the highest quality show possible, all art work exhibited must be original work, done by the artist. NO work from molds, kits or other commercial methods will be allowed.

- All paintings, watercolors, drawings, prints, computer art and photographs must be framed or matted and displayed on a suitable stand/rack or in a portfolio/bin.
- Ceramics must be handmade and individually designed by the artist. No works made from commercial kits, molds, patterns, stencils or prefabricated forms are allowed.
- Jewelers shall not use any commercially fabricated forms or settings. Only artists accepted in the Jewelry Category may display and sell jewelry.
- Artists must represent their own work. No agents allowed.
- Submitting this application is a commitment to Festival rules.

INSTRUCTIONS

NEW ARTISTS

- Applications must be postmarked by **June 1, 2023**.

- Complete all parts of the application/registration form, including slide/photo descriptions.
- Include five slides/photos only per category. Four of your work and one of your booth with work displayed.
- If you are applying in two categories, please submit two sets of slides/photos, and a copy of the application for each entry.
- Sign the general release statement.
- Enclose a check or money order for booth fees. Make checks payable to: Cumberland County Historical Society.
- Accompany your application with a self-addressed #10 business size envelope, stamped with adequate postage.

ALL ARTISTS MUST SUPPLY THEIR OWN TENT, TABLE(S) AND CHAIR(S).

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REINVITED ARTISTS

- Registration must be postmarked by **June 1, 2023**.
- Complete the application/registration form.
- Sign the general release statement.
- If requesting same space as 2022, please indicate so on registration.
- Make checks payable to: Cumberland County Historical Society.
- No slides/photos needed unless you are applying in a new category.
